RULES OF THE SHOW And Class Descriptions

1. General Rules of USA Eq and/or AQHA will be followed.
2. The Judge's decisions are final.
3. The Dress code is liberal- Safe foot gear required, over fences riders to wear approved helmets. Neat, serviceable clothing to be worn. Western riders may wear helmets. Chaps allowed, not required. This is a schooling show, but clean safe equipment is expected.
4. No profanity, abuse, or rudeness will be accepted.
5. The show committee reserves the right to change or cancel classes if necessary.
6. All Pleasure classes are open to English, Western or Gaited horses. The gaits required will be the Walk, Trot, Jog or Pleasure Gait, and Canter or Lope- depending on tack and type of horse. No martingales permitted in Pleasure classes.
7. Boots, bandages are permitted on horses in all classes, (it's a schooling show)
8. No martingales permitted in Under Saddle classes.
9. Braiding permitted but not required.
10. Grooming and Conditioning horses may be shown Western or English, English may show in a bridle.
11. Trail In Hand horses may show in a halter or bridle, whip or crop permitted.
12. Speed event horses may be ridden English or Western- Helmets recommended.
13. Class # 18 will change at each show, Adult Lead Line, May - Glass of Water Class, June - Musical Bags, Sept.
14. Championships will be awarded in these 10 Divisions, Pre Short Stirrup, Short Stirrup, Green Hunter, Low Hunter, Adult W/T, Gaited Pleasure, Junior Rider Pleasure, Senior Rider Pleasure, Trail, and Speed. An Overall High Point and Reserve will be named at each show.

Class Descriptions

- Lead Line is for 7 and under, may not RIDE in any other class, (may enter G & C and Trail in Hand)
- Pre Short Stirrup is 10 and under - may not enter classes where asked to canter or jump-
- Short Stirrup in 12 and under, riders may not enter any other classes over fences
- Walk / Trot Adult is for adults who do not desire to ride in any other Division.
- Fun Pleasure is for anyone we can get into it.
- Gaited Pleasure is open to any gaited horse.
- Jr. Pleasure is riders 18 and under.
- Sr. Pleasure is riders 19 and over.
- If we have 5 or more riders we will add a Very Senior Pleasure Division for Riders over 40!!
- Trail is open to all, English or Western, so is Speed.
